# How does the Prom Passport work?

- In order for students to receive their invite to the prom they have to complete all 8 sections of their booklet.
- IMPORTANT Section 1 and 2 will be reviewed by SLT/HOY if they do not meet these.
- They have until 4th April to have your sections completed and signed off by their form tutor.







#### Section 1 - Attendance

#### **ACHIEVEMENT**

- Your attendance from January to May must be an attendance score of 94% or more.
- If it is not then SLT/HOY will look into the reasons why and consider reasonable adjustments.

# When do I get my invite?

If all 8 sections of the passport are completed they will gain a total of 80 points.

The first 3 sections can be completed at gold standard (100% in each one = 20 points). If students receive 110 points in total they will receive a golden invitation.

This means that student will be entered into a raffle to win a prize for the Prom e.g. money off the prom ticket.





#### **Important!**

- The invitation to the prom or the prom passport can be revoked at any time if they demonstrate behaviours that are unacceptable or if they receive a suspension.
- Students have to earn their invitation to the prom. If they lose their prom passport then they will have to restart and regain all the sections they did not complete.
