Welcome Address



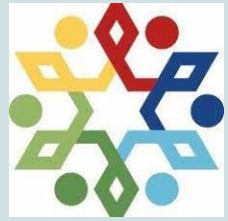

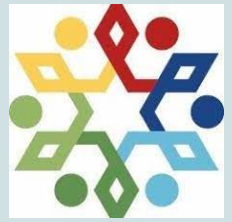
There are almost 900 of us on The Broadway campus and change over of lessons can feel VERY busy.

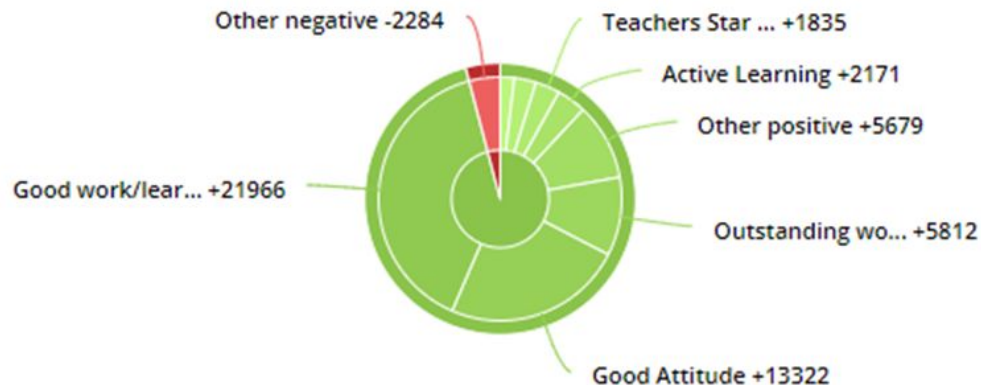
Key successes last week

Broadway Behaviour

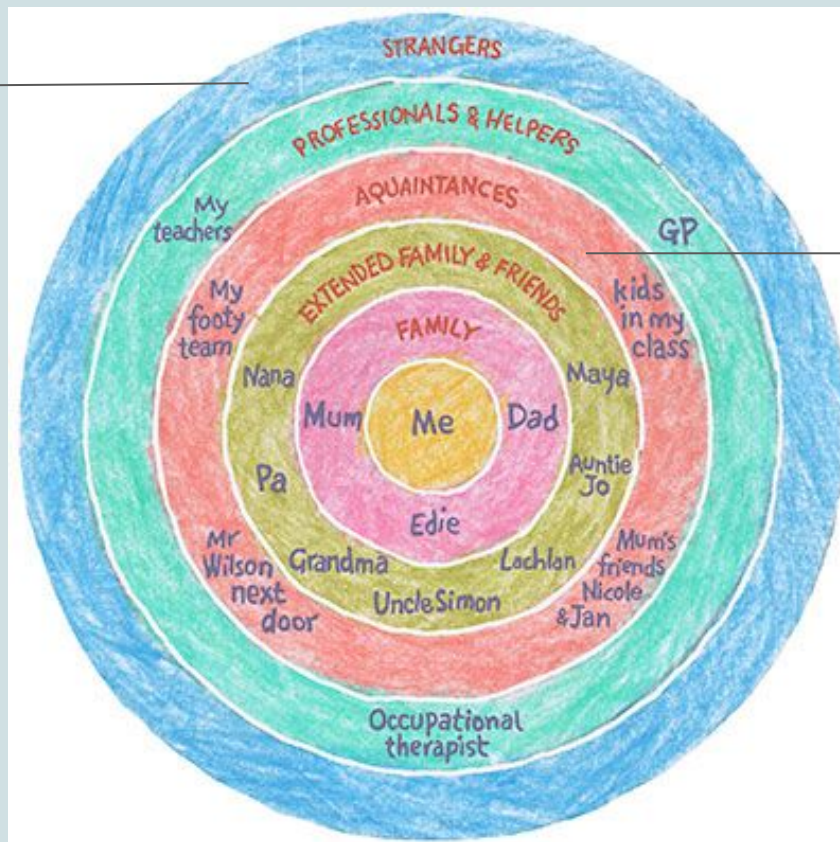
