Other food banks

Stockport has two main food bank services: Stockport Foodbank, provided by the Trussell Trust, and Chelwood Foodbank Plus.

They each operate in multiple locations across Stockport. Both food bank services operate on a referral basis and offer a food parcel containing 3 days' supply of food for a household.
