# Big Wins: Last Week

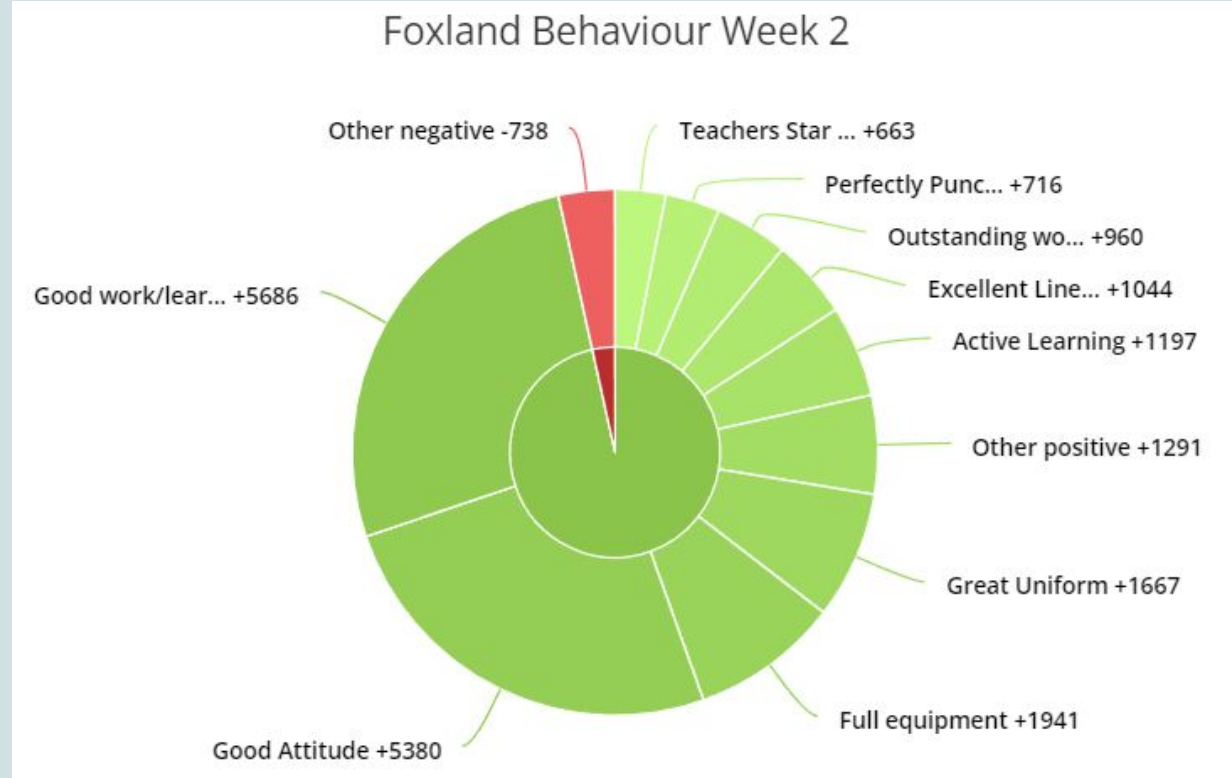
## A flying start for many...

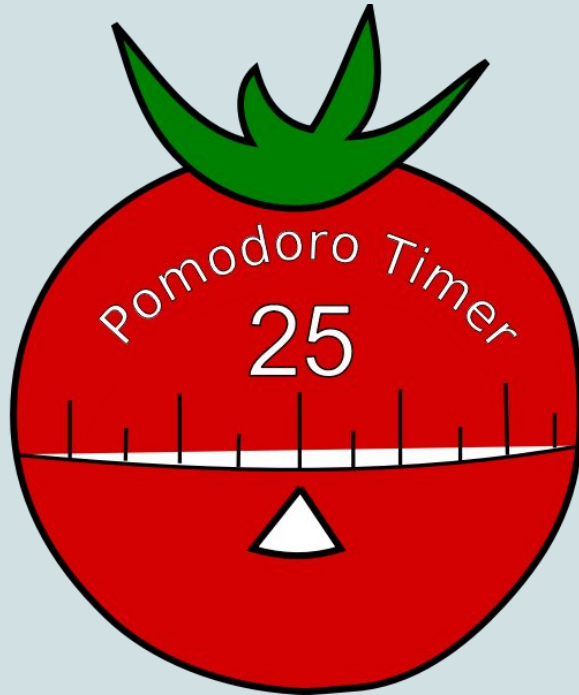
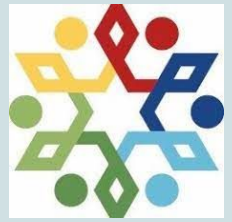
It is of paramount importance that all Year 11 students engage with their learning and that you actively participate in period 6 sessions, as these will help you achieve the best possible final grades.

**Independent study support:** All of you will work on organising your time so that you can be learning focused.

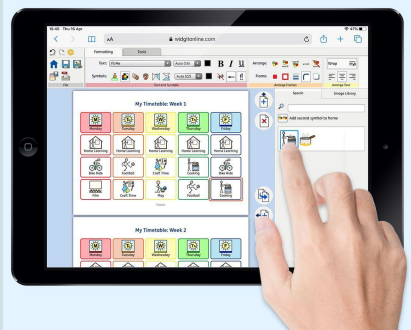

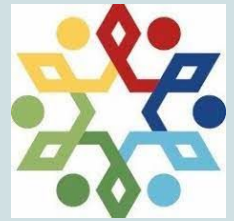
