- To support students who did not achieve the expected standard in mathematics at the end of KS2 and ensure that they are on target in maths
- To support all students in achieving their target grades
- To enable all students to make rapid and sustained progress in reading and mathematics

Summary of spending and actions

- Intervention week for Literacy cohort
- Reading programme (Accelerated Reader)
- One to one and small group reading support
- Additional timetabled reading sessions for identified students
- Ability specific reading texts purchased
- KS3 co-ordinators in maths and English
- Numeracy support programme including breakfast club
- Implementation of Doodle to allow staff to personalise learning for identified students
- Intervention catch-up lessons based on issues identified in KS2 QLA and Baseline Test QLA
- Purchase of chromebooks to ensure that all identified students can have access to on-line intervention tools during the school day (Jaguar maths & Doodle)
