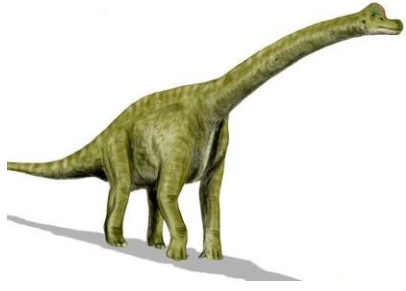

To investigate pitch using chime bars and create a sequence of long and short sounds with help (1,2,3 notes)



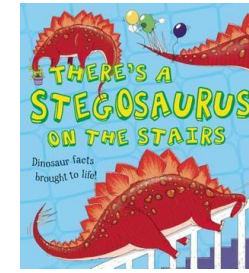
English

Talk for writing activities, learning to retell a story orally.
Use patterned language when retelling a story.

Read simple non-chronological reports and know that they contain facts.
Collect simple information about a subject and use it to write a simple non-chronological report, which contains a heading with text that relates to it.

Grammar, punctuation & spelling: Capital letters, full stops, finger spaces.

What is technology?

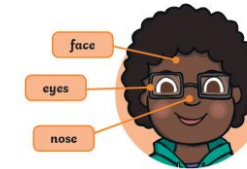


We will learn about how technology can help is everyday.
