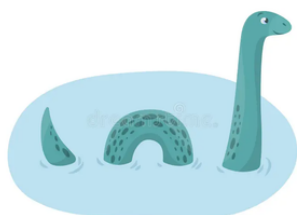
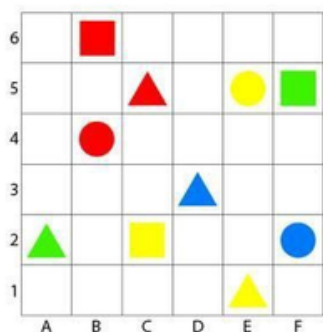
YEAR 4 NEWSLETTER
