School Improvement Plan 2023/24



Here is a summary of the School Improvement Plan for this year. This plan is the driver to improvements in teaching and learning so that we can ensure that our school continues to develop and that our children achieve well. It is written and agreed by staff and Governors and mirrors the new Ofsted Framework.

Quality of Education and Early Years

- To take part in the Voice 21 Programme to improve Oracy through school.
- To embed work on Engagement from 22-23 and ensure that prior learning is secure and expectations are high for all children.
- To continue to embed the new phonics scheme and ensure that children in Early Years and Year 1 do not fall behind. Review phonics/spelling teaching in Year 2 and KS2 for children who need support.
- To continue to develop the teaching and learning of writing across school to improve results.
- To continue to develop and improve Foundation Subject assessment.
- To further improve assessment and teaching around EAL to improve provision and results.
- To ensure that the curriculum knowledge planners are focused and that key learning is clear in all year groups.

Behaviour and Attitudes and Personal Development

- To share the new Behaviour policy with all stakeholders. To monitor the effectiveness of the 3 B's.
- To ensure that staff receive the appropriate CPD for behaviour.
- To continue to review and develop mental health and nurture support in school.

Leadership and Management

- To use the Pupil Premium and Catch up funding well to support the learning and progress of children.
- To continue to develop a rigorous programme of CPD across school, building on success of last year.
- To further improve the effectiveness of Curriculum teams across school.
