# Meal Times

- Children will go to the canteen for their pre ordered food, they will then go and sit in the dining room to eat this.
- The tables are big enough to accommodate 8 children around them.
- Children will have the options of water or squash to go with their food.
- The children are expected to scrape and stack plates at the end of the meal time.





# Accomodation

- Room sizes vary from 2-8 children in a room
- Once we know our room sizes, we will organise the children into their rooms based on their friendships.
- Children will be with a friend of their choice, we cannot guarantee they will have everyone on their list.
- Boys and girls will be kept separate.

# Toilets and washing facilities

- Children will either have an en-suite or bathroom facilities just outside their room along the corridor.
- Showers are within these facilities.

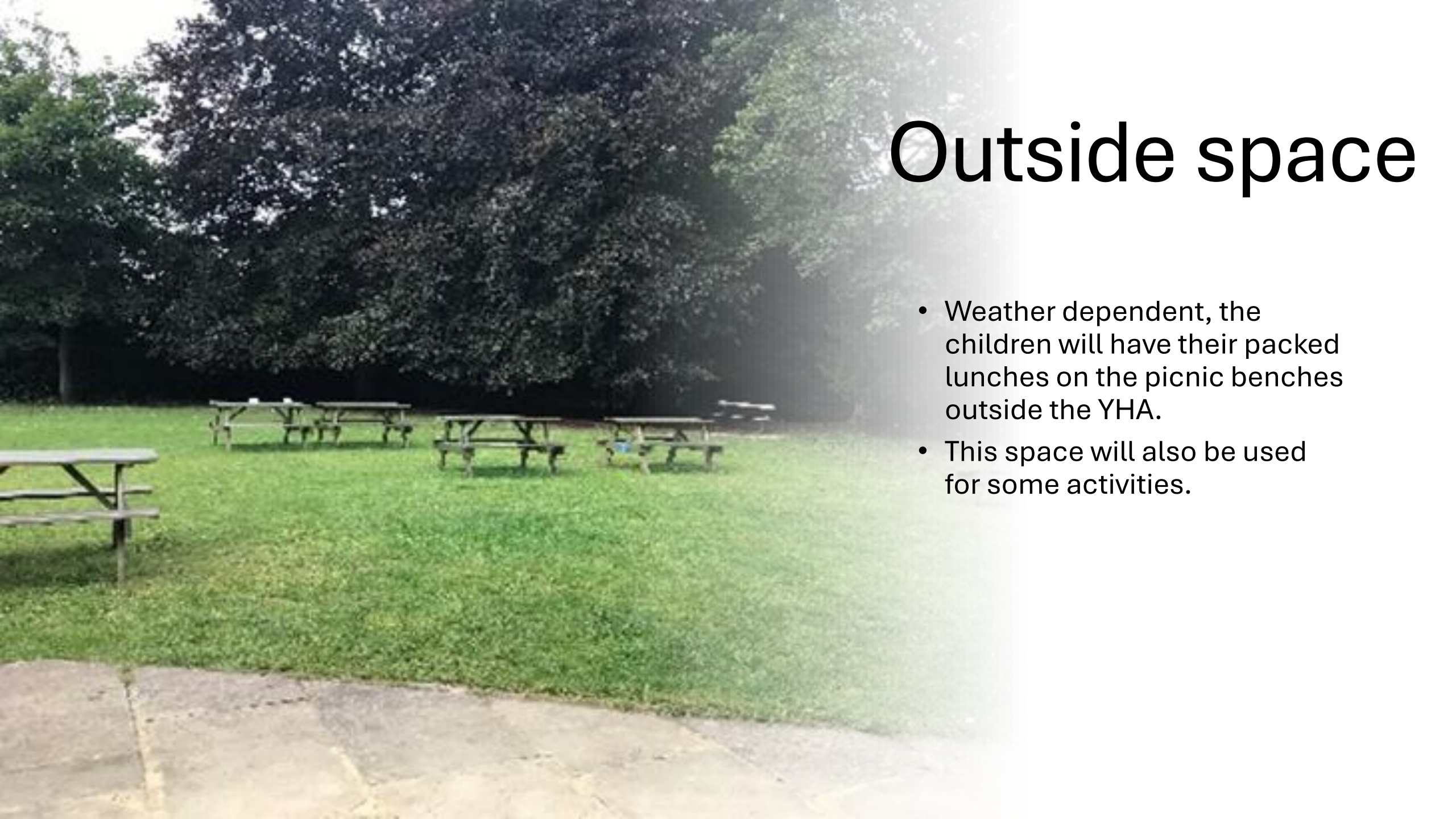
