Messages from the Year 3 Team:

Outdoor Learning – 3DC have had their final session, so this week Miss Howe will start taking lessons with 3IM. 3IM will get two lessons before half-term and then continue after the holiday. This will still take place on a Thursday morning. Please ensure you have read the Outdoor Learning letter regarding appropriate clothing.

Thank you for your patience with Beanstack. It's been troublesome getting up and running across the whole school. The children have been really enthusiastic about it, which is brilliant, and we are grateful for your support at home too.

This week's learning:

In our Maths lessons, we will be developing written methods for how to add a 3-digit number and 2-digit number together before moving on to subtracting a 2-digit number from a 3-digit number. Our English lessons will be focused on strengthening comprehension skills and planning a piece of writing that uses adverbials to show time, place and manner. In Science, we'll be learning more about the poles of magnets and the way in which they repel or attract one another. Our Geography lessons will be about finding the physical features of European countries (Greece and Norway). In our PE football lesson, children will be learning how to use the outside of their foot to control the ball and dribble. In French, we'll concentrate on consolidating the work from the previous lesson as well as learning how to ask and answer the question 'What is your name?'. In our ICT lesson, we'll be introducing the children to key network components, including a server and wireless access points, whilst also examining each devices functionality. In RE, we'll be asking how Christians make a positive difference in their community and learning about how they show commitment to church.

Whole school information
