This week's learning:

In Maths, we'll be exploring different patterns in addition and subtraction and the effect on different digits when adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s. Then, we'll move on to adding two 3-digit numbers together both when an exchange is needed and when not. Our English lessons will be focused on Chapter 20 of the BFG – The Royal Breakfast. We'll be focusing on using retrieval skills to evidence inferences about the chapter. Our writing will be focused on imitating a section of the chapter and using vocabulary to make our reader laugh. In Science, the children will be doing an end of topic review on forces and magnets to reflect on what they've learnt. In ICT, children will develop their understanding of networks by seeing examples of network infrastructure in school. In French, we'll be learning numbers 1-10. In our PE lesson, we'll be focusing on how to cushion the football when receiving a pass. Our RE lesson will be about the different types of Christianity. Our RSHE lesson will be focused on managing and coping with change. As part of Black History Month, we'll be creating some artwork inspired by our chosen figure from history – Muhammad Ali.
