This week's learning

In Maths this week we are adding and subtracting 1,000 from 4-digit numbers. We will also be comparing and ordering them. In English, we'll be reading through Harry Potter and the Philosophers Stone and learning how to create a sense of magic and wonder in our writing. In Science, we'll be learning about quiet and loud sounds and how they travel to our ears. We'll be continuing to learn about Wassily Kandinsky in Art by listening to classical music and trying to recreate the mood it creates as a picture.
