Part 2 Action 1. The Chair welcomed everybody to the meeting. There were no Apologies and the meeting was quorate. 2. There were no <u>Declarations of Interest</u> for the matters on the Agenda.

- 3. Paper 3.0 The Minutes of the Board meeting held on 21st March 2022, uploaded to Governor Hub (GH) prior to the meeting, were approved and will be signed by the Chair on GH. Matters Arising - The Action Log was updated as noted thereon. The Chair advised that Dr Greenstein had resigned as TLA Trustee as at 19th May 2022 and thanked him for his contributions to the Trust.
- 4. Reports (Exception) from Committees
- 4.1 Finance and Staffing Paper 4.1 Finance and Staffing, uploaded to GH prior to the meeting, was received and the contents and actions of the Committee noted as recommended therein. The Chair reported that he was grateful to Trustees who sit on TLA Committees for the work they do. The Chair of the Finance and Staffing Committee reported that the School Resource Management Advisor (SRMA) report had been highly complementary about the Trust's approach to the financial management of Crewe UTC, which Trustees agreed was a credit to the CEO and COO.

- 4.3 <u>Digital Strategy Working Group Update</u> Paper 4.3 <u>Digital Strategy Working Group Update</u> uploaded to GH prior to the meeting, was received and the contents and actions of the Committee noted as recommended therein.

5. Strategic Matters

- 5.1 Proposal to explore changing the name of SWS Paper 5.1 Proposal to explore changing the name of SWS, uploaded to GH prior to the meeting, was received.
 - Trustees noted that the estimated cost was around £50k and asked what this would cover, asking what help families would receive to help with their costs. It was reported that the £50k figure was the cost for new signs and to provide every SWS student with a new uniform. That uniform would be more affordable for students' families in the long term. The school signs need replacing whether the name changed or not. Trustees were keen to ensure that a name change was seen as the positive, meaningful change intended and that there were substantive, good reasons for the costs anticipated. Trustees were assured that public messaging would be handled sensitively. The Trust is taking a coordinated approach to its Crewe schools, working with the

- 5.1.1 **Trustees agreed** that the exploratory work linked to a change of school name, and approving of a change of name in principle, should proceed. Governors will be consulted and staff buy-in will be key, so any name brought for approval to Trustees must be suitable, reasonable and have a sense of agreement.

- 8. <u>TLA School Visits</u> Trustees were informed that a date of 21st June has been set for the Trustees' visit to TLA Congleton and Mow Cop schools.
- 9. <u>AOB</u> **ACTION:** The CEO/COO will provide an update on the Trust's White Paper strategy to TLA Members.

Trustees offered thanks to the Trust Director of Marketing and Operations, Mr Routes, for his work regarding Ukrainian students at Knutsford Academy.

• Trustees asked whether all TLA schools were celebrating the Jubilee. It was reported that they were. The CEO will check finalised details and ensure media coverage is considered. TLA schools have also looked to address different views on the event in a sensitive manner.
