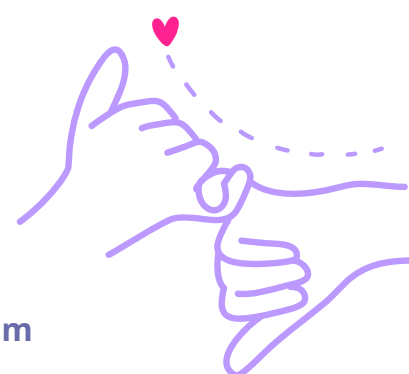
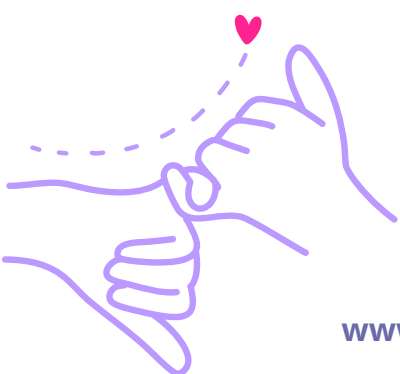


## CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

**Year 3 & 4 - Friday 24th May, 10.30am-12.15pm**

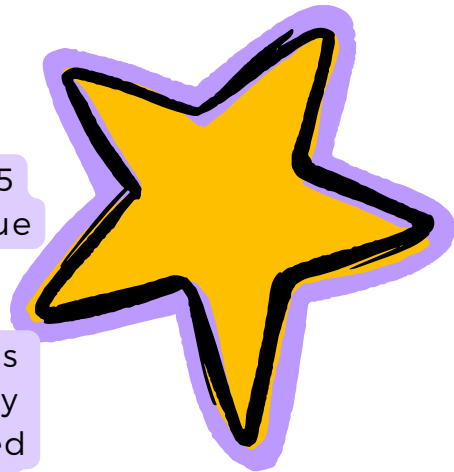
**Year 1 & 2 - Friday 24th May, 1.30-3pm**
