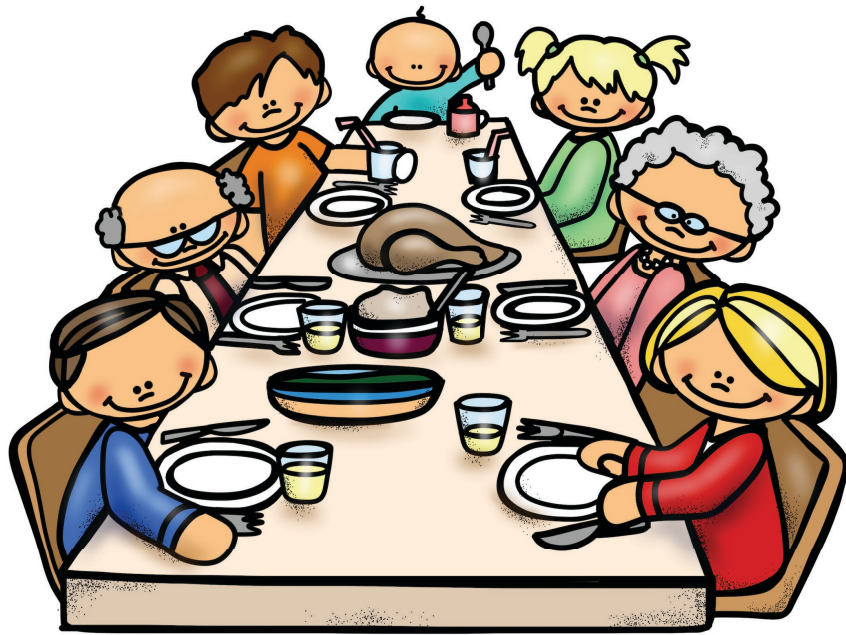

them on Facetime.



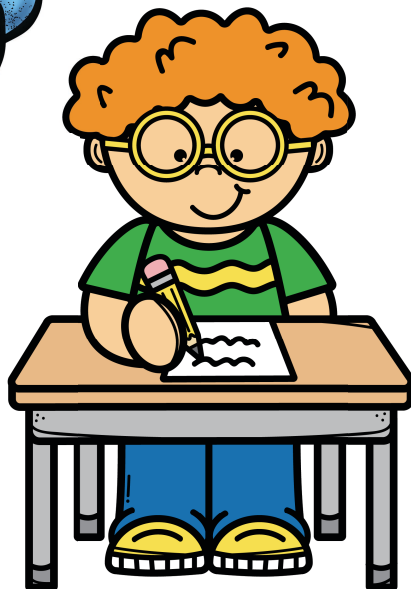
Our grandparents, aunts, uncles

bring gifts on Christmas.



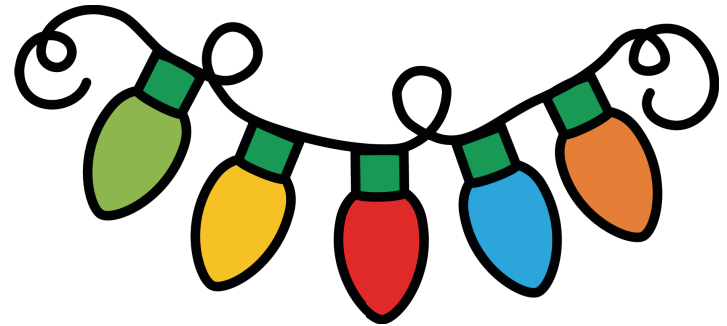
Some families go to church on Christmas. This year, we will stay home to keep safe.

people I love will be safe!



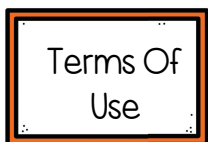
Next year, when Coronavirus is gone, I will be able to be with my family in a large group!

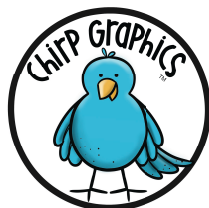
