Data Collection Packs 2015-2016

Thank you to all the Parents/Carers that have returned the Data Collection Packs. If you haven't already completed and returned your pack could you please do so as soon as possible. The information you provide is confidential and is a legal requirement. Without the **One-Off Consent Form for Off-Site & Out of Hours Activities** completed and returned your child will not be allowed to go off site on any school visits as these forms contain your emergency contact information. There is also a swimming consent form without which your child will not be allowed to take part in swimming lessons, our Enrichment Clubs begin on Wednesday 23rd September from 3.00-3.45pm, students will need to be collected by Parents/ Carers, as transport is not provided by the Local Authority.
