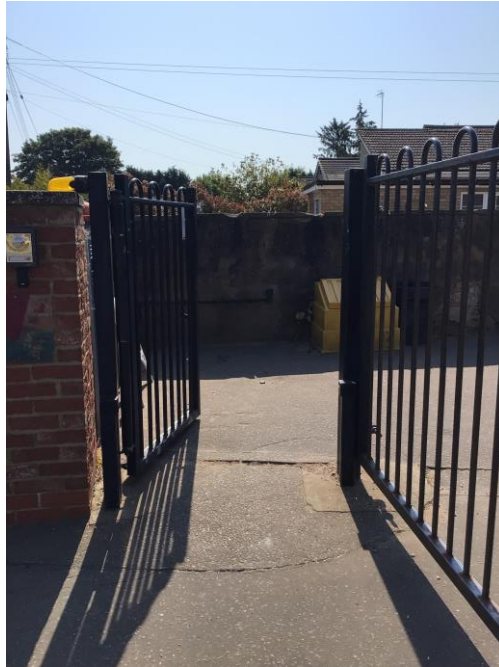

Our School Day

You will walk through the school gate.



The bell will ring and school starts at 8.45 and you will wait in a line near the bike shed. The first person can stand on the yellow line on the edge of the netball court near the old water fountains.

Your grown-ups will be waiting for you at the bike shed.

Our Morning Routine



You hang your coat and bag on the pegs with the Robin picture on them.



You will put your water bottles in the tray.

We wash our hands to make sure we stay clean and healthy.

We vote for the story we want at the end of the day and sit on the carpet ready for the register. Sometimes there might be a game for us to play.



During the day



There will be times when we sit on the carpet to learn and talk together. Here is a picture of our phonics session.

We will sit and have snack and milk in a circle on the carpet half way through the morning. At snack time can choose what piece of fruit you would like to eat and you can have a drink of milk or water.



Lunchtime at school



You will have your lunch with Robins and Starlings in the hall.

If you are having hot school lunches, you will queue up and Mrs Fox will serve your dinner.

You can choose some salad and bread to put on your plate.

Here some examples of a healthy home packed lunch. The children may bring a treat to pop in their lunch box such as a chocolate bar or cake.

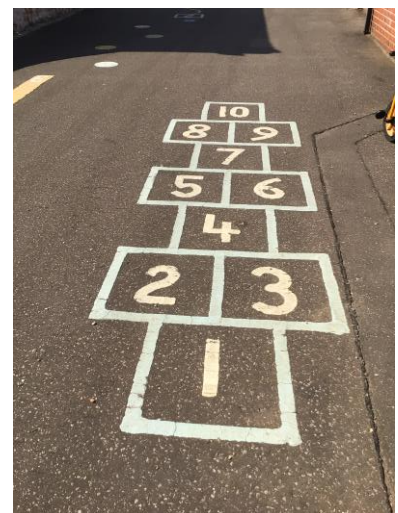
Toilets

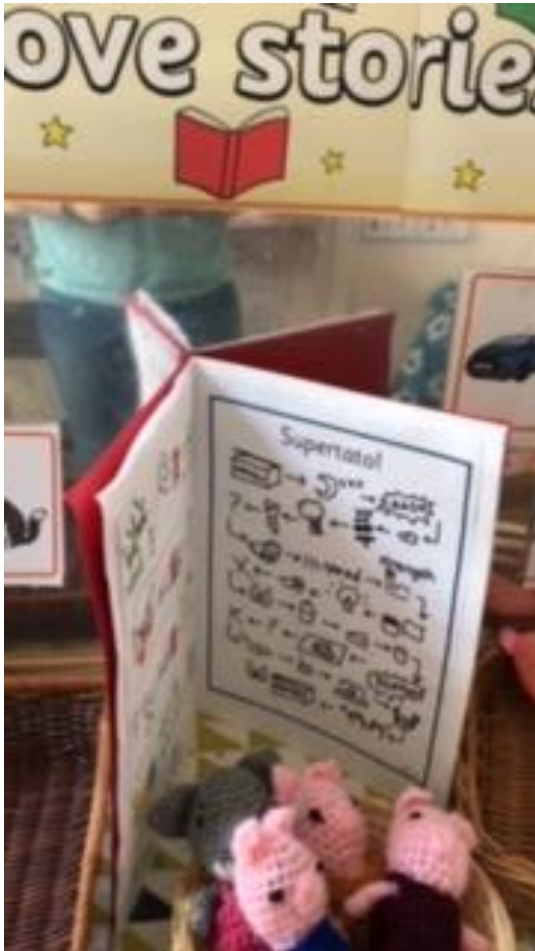


We also have the school hall that we will use for PE, assemblies, lunchtime and special events.



What Can You Do in Robins Class?

You can.....



Share a story in the book area. Or retell a story using the props and story maps.



Go on an adventure with the dinosaurs or build a town in the small world area.



Sing and dance on the stage or make up your own song and rhythm on the music wall.



Fill and pour water in the water tray or explore which way the water will fall on the water wall.



Cook some food and roleplay in the home corner.



Grow plants in the garden or feed the birds on the bird station. We like to count how many birds we have visit our garden.



Dig and build in the giant sand pit.



Build with the blocks, tyres, sticks, cones and cable drums in the construction area.



Count, build puzzles or play with the Numberblocks in the Maths area.



Get messy with our messy and sensory play.

Use the playdough to create models.



Or simply, share a game of basketball with a friend.

At home time we settle down with a blanket (when it is cold), crackling fire or crashing waves and a good book. Miss Smith will take me back out to the playground to find my adult.
