

Key Vocabulary	
animation	A visual effect that can be applied to the text or pictures included on a slide .
format	The layout of the design, text or pictures on a slide . You can also format the font, size, colour and style of text.
hyperlink	Text, images, buttons or moving images that can be used to move from document to document. They can even move from one place to another in the same document.
multimedia	Using more than one form of communication, such as text, graphics, animation and audio.
slide	A single page or image shown in a multimedia slideshow presentation.
slideshow	A collection of pages that can include different multimedia.
theme	A slide design that includes pre-existing colours, fonts and special effects, such as animations and transitions .
transition	A visual effect that happens between each slide .

What Is Presentation Software?

Presentation software is a type of computer program or app that is used to create **slideshows** to accompany a speech or presentation. Here are some examples of presentation software:








What Is a Branching Story?

A branching story is an immersive, game-like story where the reader has control of the direction a story moves in by selecting different choices and going to the appropriate page to read the outcome.

Some branching stories include dead-end choices, which result in the story coming to an end.

Other branching stories give you the option to return to a previous chapter to select a different direction for the story.

How to Create Slide Templates

Two templates are needed to create a branching story:

a choices template



a dead-end template



To create your two templates, use a 'Title and Content' **slide** layout. The title section will have a title for that part of the story and this will help to link the correct **slides**. The content text box will contain the story text. Insert and **format** one or

two text boxes to create a choice or dead end template. These text boxes will be used as **hyperlinks**.





How to Linkto Another Slide

Not all presentations need to be linear. **Hyperlinks** can be used in a presentation to show slides in a different order, rather than just in a sequence.

To create a **hyperlink**:

- 1. Create a shape, such as a square;
- 2. Add some relevant text;
- 3. Use the **Action Settings** (PowerPoint) or **Insert link** (Slides) button to link to another slide in the presentation.
