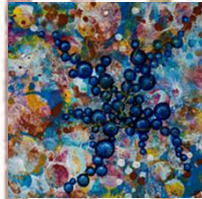

### Colour Theory

Colour theory is the collection of rules and guidelines which designers use to communicate with users through appealing colour schemes.

**Hot Colours** - Red, Orange, Yellow

**Cold Colours** - Blue, Green, Purple

**Complimentary Colours**- Opposite on the colour wheel

**A01**  
Development of ideas from one page to another. Create links with techniques and images and ensure that one page inspires another. Show research into artist/s and that you can create work inspired by their choice of media, images and / or composition.

**A02**  
Use of a variety of different materials and techniques throughout the topic. These materials should develop over time and show how you improve. You will then select the most successful materials and develop these ideas into a final outcome.

**A03**  
Different ways of recording ideas linked to the theme which includes, drawings, photographs, quick sketches, more detailed drawings. You must annotate key ideas to explain your thoughts about the work and ideas for development.

**A04**  
Present a final idea. The final piece should represent the best ideas from your experimentation, research, and drawings in your sketchbook.
