Keyboard Performance Skills

Key Words

Melody = a tune with a range of notes and rhythms

Keyboard Warm Up = exercises to improve the dexterity of all your fingers

Keyboard Note Names = C D E F G A B

Right Hand Melody Keyboard Finger Patterns = the notes that each finger should play in a piece so that you play using all your fingers to improve your keyboard

playing technique

Flat = lowers a note by 1 semitone

Accompaniment = the backing music

Left Hand Accompaniment Keyboard Finger Patterns = the notes that each finger should play in a piece so that you play using all your fingers to improve your keyboard playing technique
