

KS3 Music: Year 8

Ground Bass Meets Hip Hop

Key Words

Ground Bass Line = a repeating bass line

Melody = a tune with a range of notes and rhythms

Cello = a low pitched string instrument that plays bass melodies and bass lines

Harpsichord = a Baroque piano

Continuo = the instruments playing the accompaniment in a Baroque piece of music

Additive Texture = a different part is added on each repeat so the texture gradually gets thicker

Cyclic Structure = a piece of music based on a repeating cycle and ends the way it started

Lyrics = song words

Rhyme = words that have the same sound

Remix = a new interpretation of an existing song or piece of music with some new ideas
