

'going to' – Immediate Future Tense

WHAT IS IT?

Used when talking about something that is **going to happen**.

EXAMPLES IN ENGLISH

I am going to go shopping tonight.

You are going to eat a hamburger.

He is going to visit his friend who is called Joe.

We are going to watch a film.

They are going to go to the beach with my mum.

HOW DO I FORM IT?

1. Take the **present tense of 'aller'**:

Je vais – I am going

Tu vas – You (singular) are going

Il/elle va – He/she is going

Nous allons – We are going

Vous allez – You (plural) are going

Ils/elles vont – They are going

2. Plus an **infinitive**, for example:

aller – to go

faire – to do

jouer – to play

manger – to eat

regarder – to watch

EXAMPLES IN FRENCH

Je vais faire du shopping ce soir.

Tu vas manger un hamburger.

Il va visiter son copain qui s'appelle Joe.

Nous allons regarder un film.

Ils vont aller à la plage avec ma mère.
