# Present Tense – Regular ER Verbs



Used when talking about something which is happening now or which happens in general.

An ER verb is just a verb (infinitive)
which ends in FR.

## **EXAMPLES IN ENGLISH**

I eat a hamburger
We watch films.
They visit the monuments.

## **EXAMPLES IN FRENCH**

Je mange un hamburger. Nous regardons des films. Ils visitent les monuments.

## **HOW DO I FORM IT?**

- 1. Choose your verb (infinitive)
- e.g. parler to speak
- 2. Take off the ER and add the following endings depending on which person is doing the action:
- e.g. Nous parlons We speak

I	Je	е
You (singular)	Tu	es
He/she/one	Il/elle/on	е
We	Nous	ons
You (plural)	Vous	ez
They	Ils/elles	ent
