

# Present Tense – Regular IR Verbs

## WHAT IS IT?

Used when talking about something which **is happening now** or which **happens in general**.

An IR verb is just a verb (infinitive) which ends in IR.

## EXAMPLES OF REGULAR IR VERBS

choisir – to choose

finir – to finish

réussir – to succeed

remplir – to fill

## HOW DO I FORM IT?

1. Choose your verb (infinitive)

e.g. **finir** – to finish

2. Take off the IR and add the following endings depending on which person is doing the action:

e.g. Nous finissons – We finish

I	Je	<b>is</b>
You (singular)	Tu	<b>is</b>
He/she/one	Il/elle/on	<b>it</b>
We	Nous	<b>issons</b>
You (plural)	Vous	<b>issez</b>
They	Ils/elles	<b>issent</b>

Je choisis  
- I choose

Il réussit  
- He succeeds

Ils remplissent  
- They fill
