

Year 7 Exams – Revision Support

Year 7 examinations will take place the week commencing **Monday 3rd – Friday 7th June**. The table below identifies the subject areas that will be assessed, what your child needs to revise and how you can support them at home with this. Year 7 core examinations (English, Maths and Science) will be completed in the main hall with foundation subjects completed during lesson time in classrooms. Examination times range from 45 -60 minutes.

Subject	Exam	Revision Topics
French 55 minutes	All topics taught this academic year (Modules 1, 2 and 3) Reading and writing in the hall, speaking and listening in lesson time.	Reading and writing skills assessed in main exam. Speaking and listening skills to be assessed in lesson time. Students need to demonstrate comprehension skills and basic tools in writing, such as the ability to use verbs effectively. Tip – Make full use of the WAGOLLS provided There are Knowledge Organisers on the school website and Showbie. Pearson Activelearn tasks will be set with each class to support revision. Performing Arts 55 minutes	No exam in the hall.	Practical session to be explained by your teacher. This will take place in the classroom as a summative assessment.
Maths 50 minutes	All topics taught this academic year.	Non calculator exam. Revision tasks will be available on Sparx.
Computing 50 minutes	Online exam during lesson time. This will be composed of multiple choice, True/False and short answer questions. Music 55 minutes	Elements of Music	Listening key assessment task to be completed in lesson. Teachers will prepare students for this. Features will include recognising musical instruments and elements of music, namely tempo, dynamics, tonality & texture. Music Knowledge Organisers

<p>English</p> <p>60 minutes (Hall)</p>	<p>Analysis of an unseen Poem.</p>	<p>Written exam based on an unseen poem. You will be expected to show your reading and analysis skills about what you can learn from a poem.</p> <p>To prepare, revise key language device terminology. Know how to spot and use things like adjectives, metaphors (tenors, vehicles, and grounds), similes, etc.</p> <p>You can also prepare by practicing with higher level vocabulary found in the poem (bard, capers, play, brindled, scorn, primeval, blotched, veil, malevolent).</p> <p>Poetry Knowledge Organiser</p> <p>Ask your teacher for revision resources if you are unsure.</p>
