Year 8 examinations will take place the week commencing **Monday 10th – Friday 14th June.** The table below identifies the subject areas that will be assessed, what your child needs to revise and how you can support them at home with this. Year 8 core examinations (English, Maths and Science) will be completed in the main hall with foundation subjects completed during lesson time in classrooms. Examination times range from 45 -60 minutes.
