**Re: Year 6 transition**

As you can imagine, we are working hard behind the scenes to get everything set up ready for when your child joins us in September. We are in the process of receiving relevant information from Primary schools about what level your child is currently working at alongside additional transition information, and soon you will receive an electronic pack of data collection forms and additional documentation.

Once this information is sent back to the Academy, your child will be allocated a form group and we will be in touch again to let you know who their form tutor will be in September.

The 'Transition Hub' section of the Academy website contains up to date information such as a virtual tour of the Academy and a prospectus to help your child become familiar with the layout of the Academy. Our induction day for our new Year 7 students will be on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2026. On this day we are planning a series of activities which will allow the new students to get acclimatised, meet new friends and find their way around school. The same information will be presented twice on that evening to allow as many parents as possible to attend. There is no requirement for the students to attend but if they do, where possible, we ask that you do not bring other children as there will not be sufficient space in the hall.
