Abstract

The Orme Academy has an official school uniform which all students are expected to wear. We are conscious of cost and have kept the dress as simple as possible. The Orme Academy uniform has only 4 branded items (blazer, skirt, PE top, tie) and are available from our uniform supplier, Smart Uniform or Clive Mark. All other items are readily available from a variety of low-cost outlets. The school also has a pre-loved uniform shop – contact us for details.

Introduction

Our school uniform policy requires the support of parents and carers. We want our students to be smartly and sensibly dressed, and despite fashion trends, we aim to have a uniform which is practical, comfortable, and fit for purpose, but also reflects the ethos and values of the school. A uniform also helps prepare our students for the world of work, 'dressed for business': the business being that of learning. The policy is an agreement between the school and parents/carers that clarifies for parents/carers the required uniform as set out below. All students are required to wear PE uniform as stated below for PE and sports events. Students are expected to wear their uniform with pride.

Uniforms are to:

- show that they are part of The Orme Academy community.
- support students in being respectful
- give a sense of belonging for students
- give an identity to the community
- stop/ reduce peer pressure when it comes to clothes
- give a sense of order and purpose
- reduces bullying when everyone is dressed the same

Uniform appearance should be neat and tidy, with shirts tucked in and top buttons fastened. Students are to travel to and from school in the correct uniform and to wear it appropriately during the school day and at all school functions unless stated otherwise.

Upper half	
Blazer*	Trutex Contemporary jacket in royal blue with school badge.
White shirt	Plain white long or short sleeved with a stiffened collar, top button and capable of taking a tie.
School jumper (optional)	Navy blue or black knitted school jumper. Logos or sweatshirts are not permitted.
Tie*	Navy blue plain tie.
Lower half	
Skirt*	Trutex senior stitch down pleat skirt in pendle tartan worn without belt.
Or trousers or school shorts	Trousers and shorts should be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • plain, tailored, dark charcoal grey with waistband and zip • Trousers – full length, shorts – knee length. We do not accept: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • decoration, logos or cargo pockets • tight fitting, low cut, jeans or 'jean style'
Socks or tights	Black or grey socks - socks are not to be worn above the knee. Black or neutral-coloured tights.
Shoes	Black low-heeled shoes, enclosed at the heel and toe. No boots, trainers, canvas pumps or logos. Converse shoes and Nike Airforce are not acceptable.

PE Kit

Students are required to have either a long sleeved or short sleeved training top (* and are available from Clive Mark and Smart Uniform only) in addition to a pair of plain black shorts/ leggings/ training trousers/skort.

Miscellaneous

<p>Outdoor coat</p>	<p>An outdoor coat to be worn in cold, wet weather over the blazer, and removed when inside school buildings. Non-uniform cardigans/sweatshirts or hoodies are not acceptable and are not permitted to be worn on the school site.</p>
<p>School bag</p>	<p>Waterproof and of an appropriate shape and size to carry A4 books/ folders.</p>
<p>Stationery</p>	<p>Blue or black pens, pencil, rubber, ruler, calculator.</p>
<p>iPad and pen</p>	<p>Every student will be supplied with an iPad (free of charge) which they must bring into school every day with at least 80% of charge. Every student will be supplied with an iPad Pen (1st one free of charge – these must be replaced if lost or damaged) which they must bring into school every day charged.</p>
<p>Phone pouch</p>	<p>Every student will be supplied with a lockable phone pouch (free of charge) which they must bring into school every day, even if they do not bring in a mobile phone.</p>
<p>Religious headwear</p>	<p>If required for religious purposes, religious headwear must be plain navy or black with no pattern.</p>
<p>Hair</p>	<p>Hair should be of natural colour and no lines or extreme styles are permitted. Please contact the Academy prior to cutting or colouring hair if you are unsure of what is acceptable for school.</p>
<p>Jewellery</p>	<p>Small and plain earrings are allowed. Large hoops, dangly earrings, tunnels, stretchers, rings, necklaces, are not allowed to be worn. One watch is permitted. One bracelet is permitted. One nose piercing is permitted but must be a small plain stud. No other facial piercings are permitted. Only Academy issued badges are to be worn on the blazer. All jewellery must be removed for PE.</p>
<p>Nails and makeup</p>	<p>Any makeup and false tan should be subtle. False nails and coloured nail varnish is not permitted. Eyelashes should be natural in appearance.</p>

Items marked with an asterisk (*) are available from Smart Uniform or Clive Mark only.

Funding and support of uniform

We want all our students to be able to access our school uniform. This is our priority, and we want all students to be fully included in these lessons with the correct school uniform. If purchasing appropriate new uniform or PE kit is not possible due to financial hardship, then we are here to help. We will endeavour to stock a range of preloved uniform/PE kit items that will be available for students to use as needed. We operate a pre-loved uniform facility in school. Any parent can contact us and have a look at the stock we have. Similarly, if parents have any items of uniform/coats/bags that a child no longer needs then it can be donated to the school.

Mobile Phones and Electronic Devices

The Mobile Phone policy sets out our expectations regarding student mobile phone use during the school day. In line with Department for Education guidance and our commitment to safeguarding and learning, students are not permitted to use mobile phones at any point during the school day. To support this, we supply 'Secure Lockable Phone Pouches' for every student.

Lost Property

Within a school a vast amount of lost property is generated. All items should be clearly marked with the student's name so that they can be returned. Any property that is not claimed will be recycled after an appropriate period.

Monitoring and Evaluation

The position with relation to school dress is monitored by all staff with form tutors being the people who see students first thing in the morning. Subject staff will reinforce standards before, during and at the end of lessons. All staff will reinforce standards around school throughout the day. Sanctions may be issued if students do not follow the uniform policy to reinforce this; examples may include uniform report, loss of social time. Serious and repeated violations of the policy may result in further sanctions. Repeated uniform issues are also communicated with parents and discussed to resolve these. Reminders are given to parents through the school's regular communications. The school has the final decision over school uniform.
