Home Testing for COVID 19

As mentioned previously the government are making asymptomatic testing more available for students at college and for families of school/ college aged students.

Those who have returned to college have been offered testing on site. We will be no longer doing testing for students on site once they have completed their 3 tests. Staff will continue to be offered home testing twice a week.

We will be able to offer home testing packs to all students beginning March 15th. If you would like a home testing kit sent home, please complete the form below.

We will only be able to provide testing kits for students; however, families are able to order testing kits for their household to either collect or delivery by completing forms found here: <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/rapid-lateral-flow-testing-for-households-and-bubbles-of-school-pupils-and-staff>.

Regular asymptomatic testing continues to be an important tool in stopping the spread of the virus. Any positive home tests need to be confirmed by a booked PCR test. If a student has a positive home test they should isolate, along with the household, and you should inform us so that we can isolate any close contacts. If the PCR test comes back negative, the isolation period for all can end. If it is positive, all close contacts, including the household, will need to isolate for 10 days. We have reviewed our risk assessment and will continue to do so regularly.
