These learning tasks are optional with the idea of completing one a week if you choose. Each task directly relates to classroom based learning. Please record and share completion of these tasks in your home learning book and these will be celebrated in class.

Art: 'Take one Picture' in your own home. Look at a photograph or a painting, or a piece of sculpture and see if you can create your own version of it. Think carefully about light and shade, colour and form.	English: If you could be an animal for a day, which animal would you choose? Imagine you have spent a day as your favourite animal and write a diary entry describing what you did, what you saw, and who you met!	History: We are learning about WWI. Research what it was like for a soldier at the time of WWI. What did they wear? Where were they posted? What weapons did they have?	
Geography: We are looking at our local environment in geography this half term. Take a walk around Northstowe. Write a brochure to attract people to Northstowe. You could talk about Pioneer Par, the lakes, the growing number of schools, the transport links etc.	Year 6 Summer 2		Reading: In our text Animal Farm, farmer Jones is not an agreeable character and does not look after the animals well. Create a fact file outlining the main roles of a farmer in Britain. What does the farmer grow? Does the famer look after animals? What does the farmer sell?
History: Design a poster to advertise the roles that women could play during the WWI war effort.	Geography: What is impacting on our local environment here in Northstowe? Write a news report emphasising the negative effects of: building work on local wildlife, the increasing number of polluting cars and waste management issues.	Science: In 1976, scientists discovered there was a hole in the Ozone layer. What caused the hole in the Ozone layer? What has the been the impact of this hole on our planet and us as humans?
