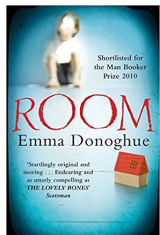

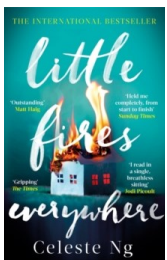
Room by Emma Donoghue

An extraordinary story of a mother and child, kept in isolation, and the desire for, and the price of, freedom.



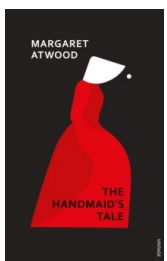
Stargazing for Beginners by Jenny McLachlan
