Roles & Responsibilities:

- To attend the 'Leadership Curriculum' once a term
- To represent and serve the whole school community
- To represent the views of students and the wider school community appropriately and through the correct channels and structures, liaising with the Student Leadership Team, Pastoral leaders & the Senior Leadership Team
- To work as part of a Bus Prefect team to achieve shared goals
- To set high standards of dress, behaviour and attitude within school and when travelling to and from school
- To report any concerns via bus@ridgewayschool.com

Criteria of how students will be appointed:

- Students in Years 9 11 will be invited to apply to become a Bus Prefect at the start of each academic year
- Students will be required to complete an application form explaining what they would bring to the role, applications will be viewed & shortlisted by the individual year group team
- Student's school conduct will be taken into consideration at the point of application

What will students gain from this:

- A broad and rich leadership curriculum, giving students skills and knowledge about leadership
- Training will be provided to bus prefects to ensure they understand their roles & responsibilities
- The position of a Bus Prefect forms a valuable part of a student's personal development, opening their mind to new levels of responsibility and participation in a very positive way
