## Welcome to the SEND Newsletter....

Welcome to the 4<sup>th</sup> edition of our SEND newsletter, which marks the beginning of another academic year.

The beginning of term in September always brings more challenges and trepidation than any other term. We are keenly aware of the increased nerves and anxiety that our students experience. For this reason, we allow students to complete the first two weeks of their fortnightly timetable without withdrawing for intervention, other than for brief introductions with their lead professional.

Once they have a chance to experience every lesson on their timetable we hope that any nerves about new classes, subjects and teachers will have been alleviated. After this setting in period we will begin to put in place ongoing withdrawal interventions for those students who need them. We will always inform you of our intention when we feel your child needs further support, and we welcome your feedback and suggestions.

During the course of the year, we have a number of opportunities for you to discuss the support your child has with the lead professionals and SEND staff. This will take place through both parent and carer consultation meetings and social activities which will allow us to spend some time together, talking, reflecting, and learning from each other.

We value the relationship we have with you as parents and carers, and we know that the conversations you have at home help out students develop trust in our school, which is so necessary for them to feel safe and secure. Thank you for your ongoing support, and we will look forward to meeting you later in the year.


