

Uniform Guide

We believe that wearing a uniform creates a sense of community for our students, we want students to wear their uniform with pride and to share a sense of belonging to their school family.

- Our uniform is smart and appropriate for our school environment.
- Our uniform is inclusive and sensitive to students faiths and religions.
- It gives a clear sense of identity.
- Offensive lettering or suggestive logos/comments on clothing, schools bags or books is prohibited.

We thank parents in advance for actively supporting our school uniform expectations and we ask that parents support this policy by ensuring that their children leave home in the morning correctly dressed with the correct equipment. Uniform is worn as a sign of commitment to The Ridgeway School and its ethos and values.



Equipment

Our equipment list ensures that students are ready and prepared to learn. When students take their assessments, including GCSE's and A Levels they will require the following equipment;

- A student planner
- A reading book
- A scientific calculator
- A transparent pencil care containing;
 - A black pen
 - ♦ A spare black pen
 - ◊ A green pen
 - A pencil
 - A ruler
 - A rubber
 - A pencil sharpener (preferably with its own compartment for shavings)
 - A highlighter
 - A scientific calculator

Uniform

Our uniform supplier is Price and Buckland. They have an online website:

<u>https://price-buckland.co.uk/</u> and a dedicated page to The Ridgeway School and Sixth Form so you can purchase the appropriate uniform.

Our uniform;

- A blazer with The Ridgeway School badge on the pocket must be worn by all students in Year 7-11. Students may choose to wear a Ridgeway School sweatshirt or cardigan with the school logo under their blazer, but not instead of their blazer.
- White school shirt/blouse (tucked in, sleeves unrolled and buttoned to the neck).
- The Ridgeway School House tie.
- Black regular length school trousers, 'skinny' or tight fitting in style is not permitted. Trousers should meet the shoe, and should not be rolled up at the hem.
- Our school skirt can be purchased from The Price and Buckland website. No other skirts are permitted.
- Large belts, buckles, zips, laces, pin stripes etc. should not be worn on either skirts or trousers.
- Plain black school shoes suitable for wearing with formal attire should be worn. Shoes that are not permitted are black trainers/footwear that are trainer in style yet labelled as shoes, daps, sandals, shoes that look like trainers, shoes without backs, and heels higher than 3cm.
- Natural or black colour tights, or plain black socks.
- Cream apron for Technology.

Further Points...

- **Outdoor coats** should be "School Type" (not leather or denim coats/jackets) and must not have inappropriate logos, slogans. These should NOT be worn inside the school building unless a decision is taken by the Principal.
- Hooded tops or tracksuits tops are also not permissible as an outdoor coat.
- Trainers are NOT school uniform and should NOT be worn during the school day. Trainers can be worn when students are taking part in a sporting activity ONLY. Information on appropriate school shoes is shown in the table in this booklet.
- Jewellery the wearing of jewellery is not considered appropriate for school and is therefore not allowed. Students can only wear one small pair of discreet stud earrings in lower lobe. (These will need to be removed for PE lessons.) No other piercings allowed. Any jewellery worn will be confiscated until the end of the half term and students who fail to remove jewellery be isolated until it is removed.
- Excessive make up, including extreme eye liner and false lashes are not permitted.
- Coloured nail varnish, decorated and false nails are not permitted.
- Extreme haircuts and styles are not acceptable. This includes dying the hair an unnatural colour.

Extreme Conditions

Uniform adjustments due to temperatures will only occur when the Department for Education issues guidance stating that there is an extreme weather warning and schools need to take action.

In all matters of uniform and dress, the decision of the Principal is final.

Purchasing

All items can be purchased from Price and Buckland online; <u>The Ridgeway School & Sixth Form College</u> (pbuniform-online.co.uk)

A school uniform sale is held annually where second-hand uniform can be purchased at a cheaper price. We also swap uniform for alternative sizes if we have availability in the uniform office.

If there are any concerns regarding the purchasing of uniform, please contact the school so we can offer our support.

Uniform Office

The school runs a uniform office open from 8.20am every morning. If a student has the incorrect uniform or has forgotten a piece of equipment, they may borrow this item for the remainder of the day. If a student attends the uniform office prior to the start of school at 8.45am they will not be issued with a uniform consequence.


Uniform Consequences

The member of staff on duty before school and the mentor during roll call will ensure that all students are wearing appropriate uniform. Where this is not the case, students should attend the uniform office where they may borrow items to ensure that they are meeting the uniform expectations.

Students will be issued with 2 demerits if they fail to correct their uniform before roll call.

If a student has a medical requirement which impacts on the wearing of any part of the school uniform, medical evidence must be provided clearly stipulating the uniform adjustment that needs to take place and the date this will cease. In these circumstances, the student will be given a medical card.
