

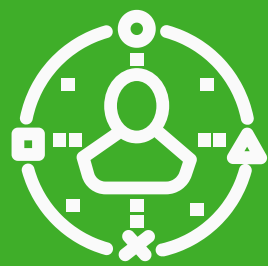

### Immersion

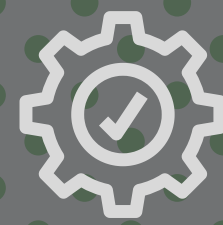
*Hook*  
*Oracy and drama opportunities*  
*Familiarisation of genre*  
*Language and vocabulary exploration*  
*Collating of word banks*

### Skill Development

*Understanding of Grammar and punctuation*  
*Application of skills to writing*  
*Model writing*  
*Developing and exploring own ideas through short writes*  
*Opportunities to discuss, debate and reflect through class, group and partner talk*

### Plan & Draft

*Embedding new learning, knowledge and skills in a longer write*

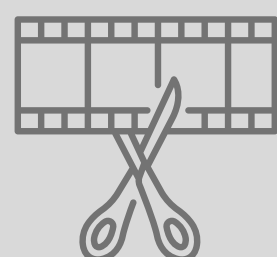
*Developing ideas collectively, as well as independently*  
*Model writes / shared writes / group writing / peer writing*  
*Planning: second layering, enhancing, revisiting, enhancing, Writing*

### Revise & Edit

*Responding to feedback*  
*Editing: making the writing right! Checking, changing errors, punctuation, spelling, grammar, clarifying for sense, Revising: making the writing better! Deleting, adding, reordering, changing words, phrases, sentences, paragraphs.*

### Publish

*Reading aloud to adults, peers, performing, audiobooks*  
*Creating a class anthology, writing display, publishing to parents, others*  
*Evaluating - did writing achieve what it was set to do?*
