Can you read the words by sight?

Is the text read with appropriate expression?
(Your story telling voice needs to be different to your persuasive and informative voice.)

Are you able to read, without stopping and starting, using the punctuation appropriately?

Things to think about...

Do you read at an appropriate speed – not too quickly, but not too slowly. This will depend on the content of the text.
