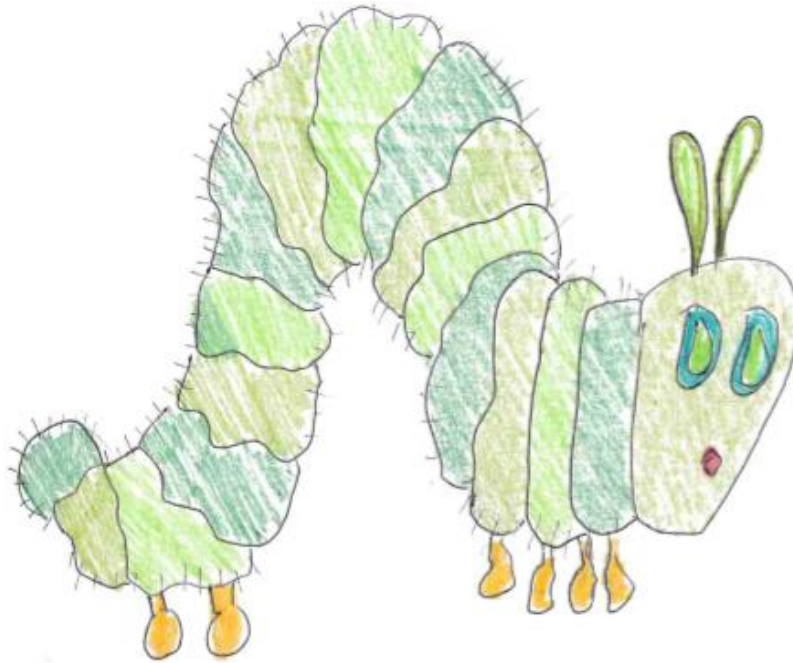


The Caterpillar's Nest

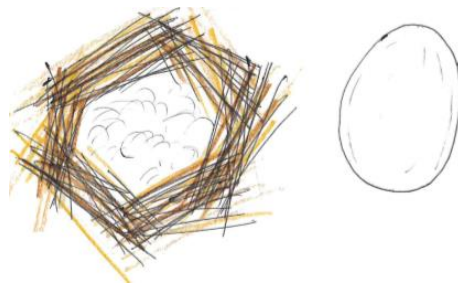

She put her egg safely in the nest, near all her friends' nests.



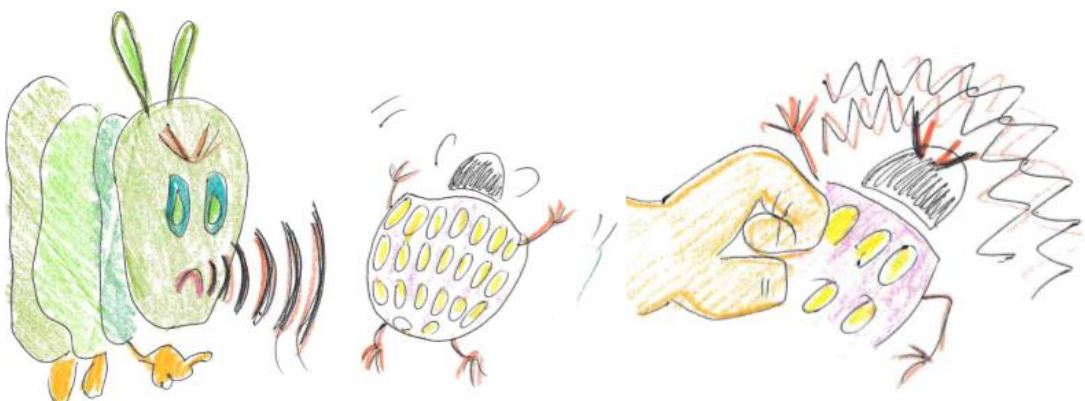
Then, along came some squidgies.



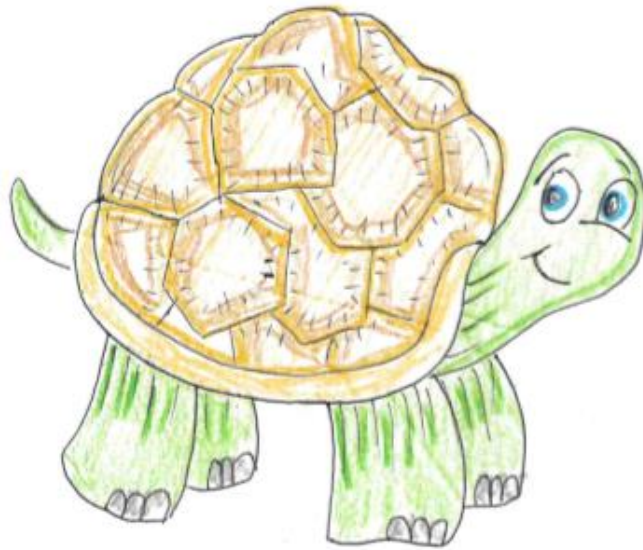
They were looking for nests to sit in.
