



One-to-one Mentoring

only assign between 1 and 4 pupils to each mentor. Like other ways you can support, mentoring would also be possible remotely, an arrangement that could save you significant time and expense.

During meetings, you will discuss the opportunities available to the students, supporting their career choices and guiding them through their first year at secondary school. The students will also lean on you for advice and to answer any questions they have about their career path or employment in general.

Understanding the diverse range of career opportunities and narrowing them down to a select few can be overwhelming for teenagers, especially those who are unsure of the path they wish to follow.

The support of a mentor is extremely comforting for them, as they know someone with experience is there to help and guide them.
