Key Vocabulary	Definition
Explorer	A person who explores a new or unfamiliar area
Replica	An exact copy or model of something
Duration	The time during which something continues
Period	A length or portion of time.
Explore	Travel through or examine an unfamiliar area in order to learn about it.
Impact	A marked effect or influence.
Representation	How someone or something is shown in a particular way

### Key Facts

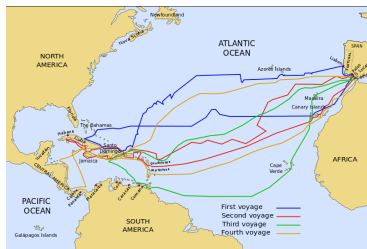
It took 4 days to travel from the Earth to the moon.



Columbus discovered the Americas by accident. He was actually trying find a new way to travel to China instead.

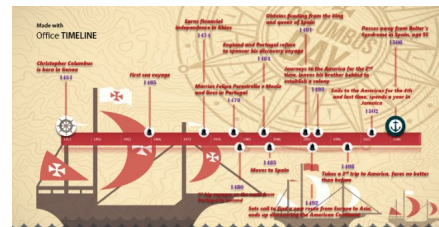
Neil Armstrong was the first human to walk on the moon on 20th July 1969 .
