Key Vocabulary	Definition
King	A man who rules a country and who inherits the position by right of birth.
Coronation	The ceremony to crown the King or Queen.
Artefact	An object made by a person that has historical interest
Chronology	The arrangement of dates or events in time order.
Monarch	A sovereign head of state (King/ Queen)
Family	A group of one or more parents and children living as a group.
Generation	All of the people born and living at about the same time

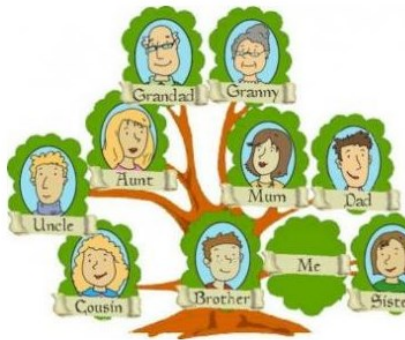

Key Facts
Charles became King on 8th September 2022 at the age of 73. He is the oldest monarch ever crowned.
The King was crowned on 6th May 2023. His mother was Britain's longest reigning Monarch
He was the longest serving heir apparent in British history
He was the first royal baby born at Buckingham Place in the 20th Century.
He is a qualified pilot and diver and a keen watercolour painter
He has founded nearly 20 charities to help people and good causes .
The word 'toy' comes from the Old English word meaning 'tool.'
