Key Vocabulary	Definition
Queen	The female ruler of an independent state, especially one who inherits the position by right of birth.
Coronation	The ceremony to crown the King or Queen.
Artefact	An object made by a person that has historical interest
Chronology	The arrangement of dates or events in time order.
Monarch	A sovereign head of state (King/Queen)
Family	A group of one or more parents and children living as a group.
Generation	All of the people born and living at about the same time

She joined the girl guides at age 11

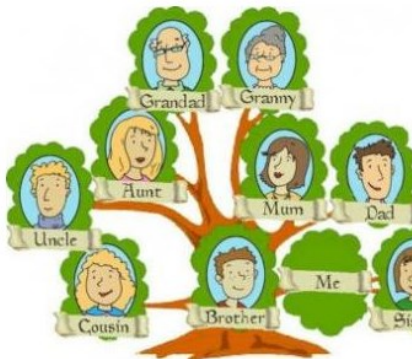
Corgis are her favourite dogs
