Legislation	A written law

Nobles	Belonging to a class of people with a high rank or title.

Courtier	Someone who is part of a monarch's or noble's court.
Yeomen	In former times in Britain, a member of a class of commoners who owned and worked on their own land.
Armada	A fleet of Spanish ships that set out to invade England.

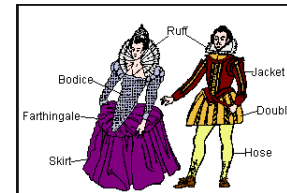

Key Facts
The Tudor rose was created when Henry VII brought an end to the Wars of the Roses
Tudor houses are very distinctive and many can still be seen today. The houses had a wooden frame with walls made from "wattle and daub"
The Tudor period is the period between 1485 and 1603. This was when the Tudors were the ruling family in England.
The first Tudor monarch was King Henry VII who claimed the throne when his forces defeated Richard III at the Battle of Bosworth Field in 1485. He ruled until his death in 1509.
