Key Vocabulary	Definition
Propaganda	information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote a political cause or point of view.
Rationing	allow each person to have only a fixed amount of (a commodity)
Evacuee	a person evacuated from a place of danger.
Reliability	the quality of being trustworthy or of performing consistently well.
ally	a person, group, or country that has joined with another for a particular purpose

Key Facts
World War II lasted six years.
Great Britain had two prime ministers during the war: Neville Chamberlain and Winston Churchill.
This was the second world war of the 20th century. The first took place between 1914 and 1918.
Some countries, such as Spain and Switzerland, were neutral and didn't get involved in the war.
The Battle of Britain was the first ever battle to be fought only in the air using planes.
Churchill was knighted on the 24th April 1953
