## Key Facts

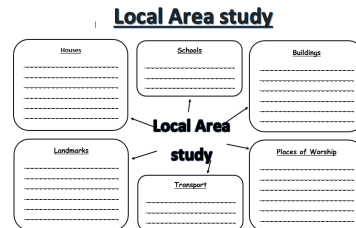
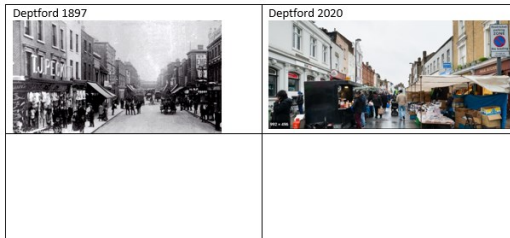
King Henry VIII founded Deptford dockyard in 1513. It was the first ever royal dockyard.

The deep ford which gave Deptford its name crossed the River Ravensbourne at what is now Deptford Bridge.

A 'tide mill' is a water mill that is driven by the rise and fall of the tide.

London's first railway, from London to Greenwich, was built through Deptford in 1836. Which means Deptford station is the oldest station in London.
