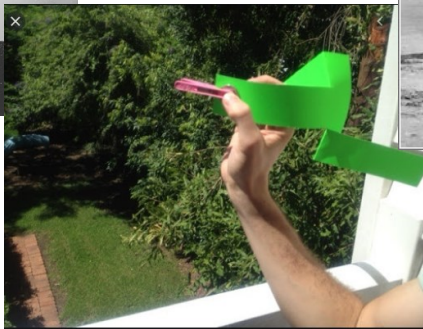
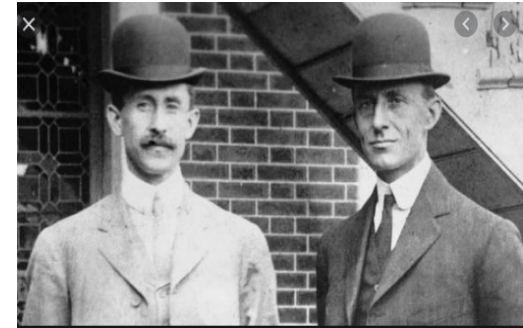


Key Vocabulary	Definition

There have been changes in travel and transport over the past century
Pioneers in the past have impacted on our travel and wider lives today.
Flight has led to countries being more accessible and connected.
We can travel further in shorter amounts of time/trade with other countries so we get food all year round.
Amelia Earhart - first female to fly solo across the Atlantic and Bessie Coleman, the first female black pilot.
