Key Vocabulary	Definition
Filbert	A brush with bristles forming a flattened oval head, used in oil painting.
Primary	Any of a group of colours from which all other colours can be obtained by mixing.
Secondary	A colour resulting from the mixing of two primary colours.
Palette	A thin oval or rectangular board that a painter holds and mixes colours on
Explore	Look at how things work and
Complimentary	A colour that combined with a given colour makes white or black.

Full name: Wassily Kandinsky
Born: December 16th 1866, in Moscow, Russia
Died: December 13th, 1944 in Neuilly-sur-Seine, France
Style/Period: Abstract, Modern Art
Famous works: <i>Concentric Circles</i> , <i>Composition X</i>
Fun Fact: Kandinsky was very sensitive to colors and sounds from an early age.
