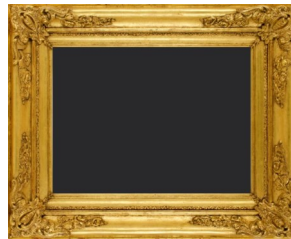
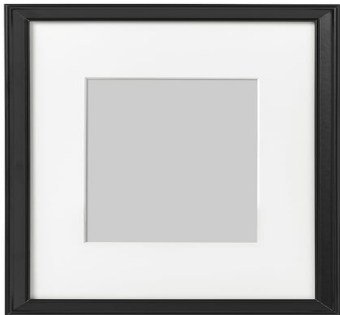

### Key Facts

IKEA, originally a mail-order business selling pencils, postcards, and other merchandise started as a commercial business in 1943.
In 1948, furniture was introduced as part of their merchandise and Ingvar Kamprad starts exploring innovative solutions such as furniture design, self-assembly and advertising.
The first computer, the size of a room, was bought. During the 1970s, computerisation enabled the introduction of computer-controlled delivery of products to stores.
Ingvar, the founder of IKEA was one of the greatest entrepreneurs of the 20th century revolutionised how retailers operate.
Ikea first brought out its now signature style of flat-pack furniture in the 1950s.
Flat-packed furniture and having a shop layout have given IKEA their competitive edge and impacted the furniture industry.
IKEA has always remained dedicated to innovation in Product design and sustainability right from its inception, hence their success.
