Panel	A flat or curved object that is set into an object.

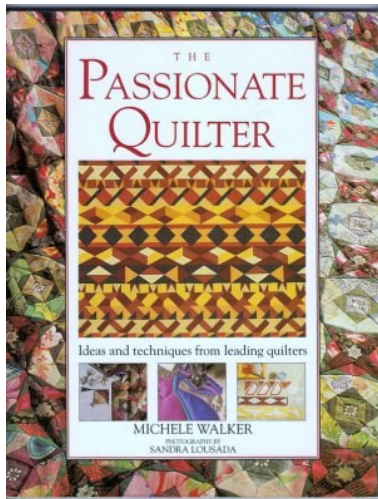

Michele originally trained as a graphic designer during the 1960's.
In 2003 Michele was awarded a three-year Arts & Humanities Research Board Fellowship at the University of Brighton, to facilitate her research into sashiko (quilting)
Quilting is used for clothing and bedding.
Quilting is a method of stitching layers of material together with a layer of padding in-between..
The history of quilting can be traced back at least to medieval times.
Quilt making is often associated with special occasions where people share the stitching.
