Key Vocabulary	Definition
Engraving	the art of cutting something especially into the surface of wood, stone, or metal
Relief Printing	printing block, which has had ink applied is put onto paper.
Block print	Technique for printing text, images or pattern by using layered areas of colour.
Dye	A substance used to add or change colour.
Layer	An application of pattern over the top of another.
Pattern	A repeated decorative design.
Interior	situated on or to the inside of something; inner.
