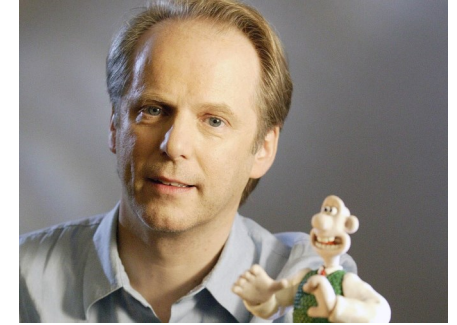

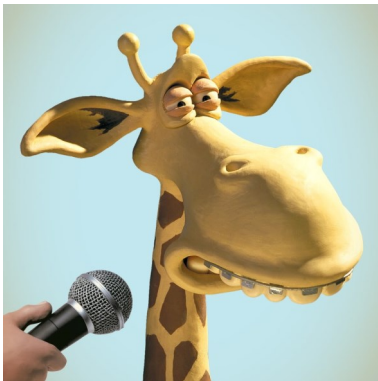

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Claymation	a method of film animation using adjustable clay figures and stop-motion photography
Stop-motion	a cinematographic technique whereby the camera is repeatedly stopped and started, for example to give animated figures the impression of movement.
Time lapse	motion picture made so that when showing a slow action appears to be speeded up.
Transition	change from one frame to another.
Frame	a frame is one of the many still images which compose the complete moving picture.
animation	the technique of photographing successive drawings or positions of puppets or models to create an illusion of movement when the film is shown as a sequence.

Wallace and Gromit films have won 4 Oscars.
Nick was awarded a CBE in 1996
